



The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Nathan Nelson, and himself, therewith to be paid hath granted bargained, and sold, released & confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain sell, release alien outfeoff & confirm unto the said James Smith, his heirs & assigns forever all the hereunto before mentioned, and described Tract, or parcel of Land, as before described, & the premises, with every of the appurtenances unto the said James Smith, his heirs, & assigns forever, to him, and them only proper use & behoof, and to and for no other use, intent or purpose whatsoever: In Testimony whereof the said Nathan Nelson hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his Seal.
