To his brother Jonathan H. Doub, who married & lives with his wife Elizabeth Doub in Washington County Maryland

To his sister Elizabeth, who married John Sharp & lives with her husband, in Frederick County Maryland

To his sister Catharine, who married Joseph Brown, and lives with her husband, in Frederick County

To the children of George Doub dec'd a brother of said Intestate who died in the year eighteen hundred and forty six as follows Catharine Doub Sophia, who married Ezra Sims, Sarah Ann Doub Isaac Doub, Caroline Doub and Mary El Doub, all of whom reside in Frederick County State of Maryland.

To the children of John Doub, who died many years ago, he for the said Intestate, as follows, Caroline who married Ezra Sims, and Mary who married Joseph Brown, all of whom reside in Frederick County, State of Maryland.
