Wherefore, and to the end that a true & just distribution of the proceeds of the sale of the said Real Estate may be made, your Petitioner prays your Honor that the case be remanded to the auditor, and that said auditor be authorized, and directed to state an account in said case, and distribute the portion before audited to Solona Mann among the children, and heirs at Law, of said deceased and as in duty he.
