

At the request of William Shields, the following deed was Recorded
 17 day of April 1801 to wit. This Indenture made & entered
 into this 13th day of December in the year of our Lord 1800 by
 and between John Shields an executor of William Shields, late
 of Frederick County & State of Maryland dec^d of the one part
 & William Shields of the County and State aforesaid of the other
 part; Witnesseth That the said John Shields, being an executor on
 a special manner, authorized appointed as executor. Together with
 James Shields, who hath since relinquished his right of executor
 ship to sell, convey & good & sufficient to make to his Real Estate
 hath for & in Consideration of the sum of Two thousand, five
 hundred & thirty six pounds, four shillings & ten pence to him
 in hand paid, or secure to be paid by the said William Shields
 before the signing, sealing and delivery of these presents, and
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by him the said John
 and that he is therewith satisfied, and Content, bargained & sold
 aliened released, & confirmed, unto the said William Shields, his
 heirs & assigns forever, the following Tract of land being & con
 sisting of part of a Tract of land called Carrolsburg and
 part of a Tract of land called Shields Adventure, and part
 of a Tract of land, Carolina, and part of a Tract called
 Charles Chances, and a Tract called Shields Delight" all sit
 uate lying and being, in the County of Frederick, enclosed in
 the following courses & bounds, Viz Beginning at the end of
 One Hundred and 40 poles, on the Seventh line of Carrolsburg &
 running thence, first N 65° E 227 poles, & an half to a line of
 a piece of land, laid off, for Shields addition to Emmittsburg
 thence with the same 2° S 74° E 55 poles to a line of a Tract
 of land, belonging to Samuel Corrick, thence with the same
 3° S 68 1/2° W 199 1/2 poles to the end, or the Beginning thereof, as the
 case may be, 4th S 19° E 21 poles, with another line of said Corrick
 line 5 S 56 1/2° W 85 poles with ditto to the aforesaid 7 line of Car
 rolsburg 6. thence with the same N 19° W 8 with Soll Byards land
 to a corner thereof 7. thence S 71 1/2° W 13 poles, to the Beginning of
 a Tract of land, called Shields Adventure, thence the same
 course 13 1/2 poles further to the end of the 45 line thereof, thence
 23 poles further the same course running across Shields Adven
 ture to the end 32 1/2 poles on the 45° line thereof, thence with
 the same reversed in courses 8 N 19° W 32 1/2 poles to the end of the
 42 line thereof 9. S 61 1/2° W 69 poles to a Stake on a line of a Tract
 of land, called Shields Delight, on a corner of Nancy Fawcetts
 land, thence with Shields Delight 6 courses 10 S 38° E 10 poles
 11 S 12 poles 12 N 57. W 56 poles 13. N 40 1/2° W 28 poles to a bound
 ed black oak, at the Beginning of Shields Delight 14 N 60°
 W 14 poles, 15 N 14° E 17 poles to the 2^d line of Samuel Corrick's
 part of Carolina 16th thence with the same N 68 1/2° W 54 poles
 17 S 53 1/2° W 119 poles to the end 43 poles on the fifteenth line
 of the Reentry in Emmitts Fawcetts 18 thence with ditto in courses,
 N 62° W 7 poles 19 S 68° W 30 poles, 20 S 68° W 48 ps 21 N 31 1/2°
 E 144 ps 22 N 20° W 15 ps with the given line of Shields part
