 Court, sitting as a Court of Equity. The bill of Complaint of John  
 Markell of Frederick County shows That heretofore to wit, on the  
 9 day of March eighteen Hundred and Thirty seven, a certain Ru-  
 dolf Keller of said County, being indebted to your orator, in the  
 sum of Two Hundred Dollars, current money, assented to your  
 orator his promissory note of that date for that amount, payable  
 Twelve months after date, and intending to secure the payment  
 thereof, unto your orator did by his deed of that date, convey-  
 unto your orator, and his heirs, Certain Real Estate, lying in  
 said County, and particularly described in said Deed to which said  
 Deed there is a condition annexed, that it be void on payment  
 by the said Rudolph Keller, to your orator of the aforesaid  
 sum of money, with Interest thereon from date of said note  
 on or before the Ninth day of March, eighteen Hundred & Thirty  
 eight, as by said promissory note, marked Exhibit A, & a Copy  
 of said Deed marked Exhibit B herewith filed as part of this  
 Bill, will more fully appear. And your orator charges, that  
 no part of the aforesaid sum of money, or the Interest accruing  
 thereon has been paid, to him, although the time limited for pay-  
 ment thereof, by the Condition aforesaid has passed & payment  
 thereof has been duly demanded by the said Rudolph Keller. But  
 the whole of said sum of money & Interest as aforesaid remains  
 due & owing to your orator To the end therefore that the said Ru-  
 dolf Keller may answer the several matters & things herein be-  
 fore stated, as fully, and particularly as if they were here repeated  
 and he thereunto specially interrogated, and that the premises a-  
 foresaid, or so much thereof as may be necessary may be sold for  
 payment of your orators claim, with Interest as aforesaid, and  
 that your orator may have such other, or further relief as his case  
 may require May it please your Honors to grant unto your orator  
 the writ of Subpoena against the said Rudolph Keller, of Frederick  
 County commanding him to appear in this Court, at some day certain  
 to be therein named to answer the premises, & abide by & perform  
 such decree as may be passed therein & as in duty he  
 doeth.
