

 peace of the State of Maryland in and for Frederick County aforesaid
 personally appeared John Flook and Barbara Flook his wife they
 being known to us, of our own personal knowledge, to be the persons
 who are named & described as, and professing to be the parties -
 in and to the foregoing deed or Indenture & severally acknowledged the
 said Indenture, or Instrument of writing to be their respective
 act & deed, for the purposes therein expressed. The said Barbara Flook
 having signed & sealed the same before us & out of the presence and
 hearing of her said husband, and the said Barbara Flook being
 by us examined, out of the presence, and hearing of her said hus-

 ure and declareth and saith that she doth execute & acknowledge


