Believing my aforesaid son John Brutaker, incapable of preserving and managing real property, I do therefore give and grant to my trusty friend Valentine Doot my plantation on which I now reside, containing 220 acres more or less together with all my mountain lots in trust and care for the sole use and advantage of my aforesaid son John Brutaker until his death with this proviso, that if my aforesaid son can satisfy the Orphans Court of Frederick County by three reputable neighbors, that he is so changed as to be able and capable of managing temporal affairs to such degree as men generally are, that then he be put into full and entire possession of the real property aforesaid as fully as it is now in mine. After his death in every event I bequeath it to his lawful heirs forever
