- 1 S 30° N 32 ps to a stone
- 2 S 60° E 20 ps do
- 3 N 30° E 32 ps do then
- 4 S 58° 34' E 158 1/4 ps do at the beginning of
 'Fogles Inheritance'
- 5 S 49° N 40 ps to a stone
- 6 N 68° N 59 1/2 ps do
- 7 S 83 1/4° N 23 1/2 ps do
- 8 N 82° N 205 ps do on the 5th line of
 Beard's Delight extended and with it connected to
 correspond with former running
- 9 N 1° E 68 ps to a stone
- 10 N 10 1/2° E 30 ps to a large white oak tree
- 11 N 10 1/2° E 9 ps to a stone
- 12 S 75° E 21 ps to a stone at the end of the
 2^d line of a deed from Jarrs Stacey to Peter Bond
 dated June 15 1773 for 75 ps of land, then with the
 given line thereof reversed N 19° E 37 1/2 ps to a stone
 in the middle of the road then with a straight line
 to the beginning containing 162 1/4 a + 27 ps
