At the execution of the annexed Commission issued out of the Circuit Court for
Frederick County sitting as a Court of Chancery to A. Wilson Jr & J. S. Nelson directed empower-
ing them to examine witnesses in a cause there depending in which John Reifender is Com-
plainant, and Solomon Beard Admr. of John Beard and others are defendants, the undersigned
Commissioners having previously taken the oath prescribed by the Court and recorded in the Clerk's
office did appoint the 25th day of June 1852 to examine witnesses when John M. Foyle a
witness of lawful age produced on the part of the complainant being duly sworn answers
To the first Interrogatory herewith filed and returned on part of complainant - That he knows all the
parties complainant and defendants and has known them for many years.

To the second Inter. He answers he did know John Beard formerly of Frederick County, Beard
is now dead, he died the last day of December 1851, without a will.

To the third Inter. He answers John Beard left a widow and children, the widow's name is
Sarah Beard, the names of the children are George Washington Beard and John Thomas Beard
one 5 years old and the other about one year of age, of course infants under 21 years.

To the fourth Inter. He answers he did have real estate, it is located in Woodborough District
Frederick County one part contains about 166 acres or more and there is another lot about 1 1/2
miles from the above property which may contain 12 or 15 acres more or less.

To the Last Inter. He answers he knows nothing further.
