The Bill of Complaint of William T Preston of Frederick County, who sues as well for himself as all other creditors of George Miller, late of said County deceased, who will come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit, humbly shews that George E Miller late of said County deceased was in his lifetime indebted to your orator in the sum of twenty one dollars and twenty cents for sundry matters and things properly chargeable in account and your orator files herewith his probated account thereof marked Exhibit No 1 which with all other Exhibits your orator prays may be taken as part of this his Bill of Complaint And your orator further charges that the said George E Miller, being indebted as aforesaid unto your orator and to divers other persons in large sums of money, and having real and personal estate of value, departed this life on or about the seventeenth of December Eighteen hundred and fifty two intestate, leaving a widow named Rebecca Miller, and Frederick D Miller, a brother, Susanna Staley wife of Tobias Staley, a sister & Rebecca Musser wife of James Musser, a sister his only heirs at law all of whom are adults and all of whom reside in Frederick County and to whom has descended said real estate, and your orator further charges that administration of all and singular the personal estate of the said George E Miller hath been lately granted by the Orphans Court of Frederick County unto the said Rebecca Miller of said County, who in virtue thereof has possessed herself of said personal estate but your orator is informed and believes that the same is not sufficient to discharge all the debts due and owing by the said intestate, at the time of his death, and
