Peter Arnold et al } To the Honble. W. Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity. The Petition of Peter Arnold, executor of David Arnold dec'd. & Trustee for the sale of the Real Estate of said David Arnold shows that at the time of his death the said David Arnold left a negro woman who is very old & utterly unable to support herself and she is therefore a burden on the Estate Your Petitioner further shows that the personal Estate has been settled & closed long since That your Trustee has now in hands the sum of Three Thousand and Thirty Nine dollars and Ninety four cents which is the final amount from sale of Real Estate of said David Arnold Your Petitioner therefore prays your Honor to pass an order authorizing your Petitioner to retain in his hands a suitable sum to be put out at Interest during the life of the said Negro Peggy, in order that the Interest thereof may be applied to her support and as in duty bound &c.

Frederick County, to wit: Be it remembered that on this 25th of April 1853, before the subscriber, a Justice of the peace of the said County personally appeared Peter Arnold & makes oath that the facts stated in the foregoing Petition are true as stated.

Nelson On reading the foregoing Petition and affidavit & it appearing to the Court that the Petitioner is entitled to the relief prayed It is this 25th April 1853 Ordered that in stating the final account in this case the auditor audit the sum of one thousand Dollars, to the executor & trustee to be by him invested for the support of said Negro Peggy W. Nelson.
