

Your Trustees sold Lot No. 11 on said Plat. Containing four acres & 35 ps. to William Paxton at and for the price of thirty - dollars per acre. the purchase money therefor amounting to One hundred, and twenty seven dollars, 12 1/2 Cents.

Your Trustees then sold Lot No. 12 on said Plat. Containing seven acres, and seven perches of Land to John Taylor for the sum of thirty dollars per acre, the purchase money therefor amounting to two hundred, and eleven dollars & 3 1/4 cents.

Your Trustees then sold the Lot designated in the plat filed as Exhibit A, to Trustees Just Reports of Sales, as the School House Lot. Containing one acre, one Road, and two perches, to Robert Brooks, Jasper Peddicent, and Robert Sumner Trustees of Primary School No. 85, for Frederick County, at & for the sum of ten dollars.

Your Trustees then sold Lots Nos 1, and 2, on the plat herewith filed as Exhibit C to Trustees. Second Report of Sales Containing twenty seven acres one Road & 10 ps. of Land to George Kimmel for the sum of twelve dollars per acre, said purchase money, amounting to three hundred and fifteen dollars, & 90¢.

Your Trustees also sold Lot No. 3, on said last named Plat. Containing three acres two Roads, & sixteen perches of Land to John Kimmel, for the sum of Fifty dollars.

Your Trustees further Report that the purchases above set forth were the highest that could be got, for said Land & Report the amount of Sales \$1520. 02 1/2¢

Your Trustees further Report, that on the 26th day of June 1852, after having given three weeks public notice as required by the Decree in this cause, of the time, manner & terms of sale in addition to other Real property then sold & heretofore reported, they sold to John Young at Public sale the being the highest bidder therefor, the field designated in the plat filed as Exhibit A, to Trustees' Just report of Sales as the Bottom, Containing Ten acres, and thirty five perches, at and for the sum of fifty - dollars per acre, the purchase money for the same amounting to Five hundred, and ten dollars, & 95 3/4 Cents (\$510. 95 3/4, and that in drawing the first Report of Sales, they by accident omitted to state that they sold said Land to John Young, at and for the price as therein stated & for the purpose of correcting said omission your Trustees beg leave to report sale at length & to state that the amount of the purchase money was by the auditor included in the amount of sales then reported)
