Robert Nelson } No 2323. Equity In the Circuit Court for Frederick County. - Joshua Dill, one of the creditors of Jacob Walker, to the amount of about sixteen hundred Dollars. objects to the allowance of Fifty Dollars to Messrs Palmer & Eichelberger Solicitors for filing the Bill of Complaint in this case, stated in the second Report of the auditors in this case, and shews, and states the following objections to the allowance of said sum to wit.

Because the said Bill of Complaint was filed in pursuance of an arrangement entered into by certain creditors of the said Jacob Walker, at the instance of Robert Nelson, whereby an effort was to be made to displace the said Isaac Walker as Trustee & substitute the said Nelson, and another as Trustees in his stead, and an agreement was signed by certain of said creditors to subscribe their several Propositions towards paying to the said Robert Nelson, all such fees, costs and expenses, as he might incur in making said efforts, and the said Messrs Palmer & Eichelberger were employed by said Robert Nelson, who was the Complainant in said bill, under & in consequence of said arrangement & agreement to carry out, and effect the object of such arrangements and that the bill was filed for that purpose; as is manifest from a reading of said bill, and another paper filed in said bill, and the objectant therefore alleges that said Messrs Palmer & Eichelberger had a right to look to said Robert Nelson for such fees as were contracted by him to be paid to them services in filing said bill and
