To the Honble William Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity. The Petition of John M. Carpenter of King Georges County, in the State of Virginia Respectfully states, That he has been duly appointed by the County Court of King Georges County guardian for his two children William Henry Carpenter, and Julia Rebecca Carpenter, and has duly qualified and bonded as such guardian, as will fully appear by the certificate of the Clerk of the County Court for said County herewith filed, as exhibited A to this Petition. Your Petitioner further states that said W. H. and Julia R. Carpenter are now, and ever since the death of their mother Rebecca Carpenter in the fall of 1849 & in fact ever since their birth, have been in the care, custody & possession of your Petitioner. That said W. H. Carpenter is now over ten years of age, and Julia R. now over five years of age that said Infants, are entitled from the Trustees in No. 2272 Equity in your Honble Court, from the proceeds of the sale of the Real Estate therein reported, to the sum of one thousand and twenty one dollars & twenty four cents, being the sum awarded to each one of said Infants, in the auctors Report filed in said Case, which said Report has been duly ratified & confirmed they are also entitled each to the sum of Two hundred and sixty four dollars fourteen & 3/8 cents being the sum awarded to each one of them, in the auctors Second Report filed in No. 2271 Equity in your Honorable Court from the proceeds of the sale of the Real Estate of the late Plummer James Sr. &c. making the amount to which said two Infants, are entitled from these two sources nine hundred & twelve dollars & seventeen cents, Your Petitioner has received as such guardian from Samuel Hart, executor of Isabella C Bryant, the sum of Three hundred dollars, and Twelve Cents, being their proportion of the Estate of Isabella C Bryant and also from John Montgomery Sr. Surviving Executor, of John Montgomery Sr, &c the sum of Two hundred and forty three dollars & one cent, making the full amount received, and to which they are entitled as above fourteen hundred and sixty one dollars & 589 Your Petitioner further states that said minors are not entitled to rents, and profits from any Real Estate as your Petitioner is informed and believes. Your Petitioner further shows, That as such guardian he gave bond in King George County, which Bond, with the security therein is amply sufficient for the full amount thereof, and for all that may come into the hands of your Petitioner, as will appear by the affidavits herewith filed as Exhibits B to Petition. Your Petitioner therefore prays your Honors to pass an order on said Trustees, in No. 2271 & 2272 Equity in your Honorable Court, to pay over to your Petitioner the amounts awarded to the said W. Henry Carpenter & Julia R. Carpenter in the auctors filed in said Cases in Equity and your Petitioner will ever pray &c,
