sheweth - That by a Decree passed by Frederick County Court, as -
a Court of Equity in N^o. 1648 Equity - Edward Lynch Esq^r. was ap-
pointed Trustee to sell the Real Estate of Baker Jameson, late of
said County dec^d. That the said Trustee sold to Benedict Boond, Lot
N^o. 26 situate in the town of Newsville, which sale was Reported -
to and finally ratified by Frederick County Court as a Court of Equi-
ty, and the whole purchase money paid to said Trustee. That afterwards
the said Boond sold all his Interest in said Lot N^o. 26. to Tilghman
