said release had been lost, or destroyed. That the Auditor of this  
Court is about to state an audit. distributing the proceeds of the  
sales of the Real Estate aforesaid, in this cause set forth to the heirs  
entitled thereto. That the said Baker A. Jammison hath been made @ -
