

the latter having been made, upon an order of Resale, at the risk of the Estate of Mr Lee a former purchaser, who failed to Comply with the terms of sale, made to him by Edward A Lynch the former Trustee in this case. This last named sale I find was of the same property originally sold to Mr Lee for the purchase money of which the note of the said Lee was given to the said Lynch, as Trustee, and by him charged against himself as Cash, but which was afterwards transferred by William Lynch Executor of the said Edward A Lynch to Ebenezer Stone the present Trustee in payment of the amount ascertained to be due & owing to this Estate by the former Trustee, deceased, on account stated in this case between the said Executor, and this Estate, so that it appears that no Cash was paid by, or is due, from the said Executor to the said present Trustee on that account, the Transfer of the said note having fully closed said account. I then ascertained the amount really due to the Estate, under trust, in this case by the Estate of Mr Lee - This sum together with the proper proportion of Costs and Expenses I have deducted from the purchase money bid by the said O'Hershey, allowing the difference to the Administrators of Mr Lee the resale having been made by order of this Court, at the risk of the Estate of Mr Lee, I have also taken testimony, and thereby ascertained that there was by release an entire extinguishment of the Interest of Henry Jamison, in favor of the other heirs and I have accordingly distributed the net fund without reference to the heirship of said Henry Jamison Nov 14/53
