

James & Lane and George J. Lane as surviving children of William M. Lane a deceased brother each one thirty fifth part of said nett proceeds To James B. Lane Estkney's Lane Hamst. Lane and Mary Baker Childen of a deceased brother Elliott J. Lane, each one twenty eighth part of said nett proceeds - Your orators further charge that of said distribution there yet remains unpaid to said parties the sum of twenty five hundred, and twenty five dollars, with the accumulated interest thereon from the 27th day of January A.D. 1853 the same not having yet been received from the purchaser of said Real Estate by William M. Hamst. the Trustee in said Cause N^o 2443 Equity, which said Trustee is also a party Complainant to this bill, as administrator of Joseph E. Lane and that the said Balance of unpaid purchase money when paid to said Trustee, and said accumulated rents now had brought into Court by your said Orator Andrew Kenney for distribution, constitute a sufficient fund, under the Control of the Court to be distributed in such manner as to correct the errors, and inequalities of said Original distribution, and to effectuate a full and equitable adjustment of all the rights of said several parties in the premises. Your orators therefore charge - that a new distribution should be made, an account taken - according to the rights of the said several parties under said Original bill as Connected by the allegations, and new matter set out in this their Bill of amendment, review and supplement. and your orators charge - that the following parties are entitled to distribution - according to their titles by recent devise and as creditors of the fund as follows to wit The said Alexander B. Butler as administrator as aforesaid to the one fourth part of the amount of sales, and of the accumulated rents in satisfaction of her claim as a creditor as aforesaid, and the remaining three fourths of proceeds of sales, and accumulated rents should be divided amongst the surviving brothers & sisters of said James, & Lane and the heirs at Law, and devisees of those who have deceased and to the personal representatives of such as have deceased since the accumulation of rents in the hands of said Andrew Kenney as follows. To John W. Lane, a surviving brother of said deceased, one month - To Rebecca Hunter & Andrew Kenney in right of his wife Mary as the surviving children and heirs at Law of a deceased brother Meloughby M. Lane each the one half of one month - To Isaac M. Carter & Mary F. Martin, only children of a deceased sister Sarah M. Carter, each the one half of one month, and as devisees and legatees of Mrs. Mary J. Woodford a deceased sister as aforesaid, each the one sixteenth of one month - the said sixteenth of one month of Isaac to go to his Trustee John Martin as expressed in said will as aforesaid To Meloughby M. Webb George Webb, and Edward M. Webb, and to the said Infant children of John M. Webb dec'd viz Susan E. Webb and George M. Webb, who were the only children & heirs at Law of Martha Webb, a dec'd sister of said James & Lane, each of the said sons, the one fourth of one month, and each of said Infants the one eighth of one month, and as devisees of said
