because as is alleged said Real Estate was in part purchased
with funds properly belonging to said widow as her share of the
personal assets of her de. husband, and to reform the Decree
of distribution further so as to let into a participation of the
funds under the control of the Court, the several devisees
of Joseph. E. Lane & Mary F. Woodford, deceased brother & sister of
said James S. Lane which said Joseph & Mary were averred erroneously
in said Original Bill to have died intestate, and also to let into
the distribution Susan E. Webb and George W. Webb, the children and
heirs at Law of John Webb a deceased son of Martha Webb a de. &
sister, they not having been named as parties in said Original Bill &
not having been accounted in the distribution, and for the further
purpose of making distribution of the accumulated rents & profits
of said Real Estate, collected by Andrew Kennedy, one of the Com-
plainants to this bill, and which he brings hereto this Court,
to be distributed. The bill sets forth the respective titles, claims
and proper shares of the several parties in the funds, under the control
of the Court, and states, that all of said defendants, reside out of the
limits of the state of Maryland, and beyond the reach of the ordi-
nary process of the Court - It is thereupon adjudged & ordered
that the Complainants, by causing a copy of this order to be pub-
lished in some newspaper printed in Frederick County once a
week for one month, prior to the 26th day of April next give
notice to said absent defendants of the object and substance
of this Bill, and warn them to appear in this Court, in person
or by solicitor, on or before the 27th day of July next, to answer the
premises and show cause if any they have why a Decree should
pass as prayed.
