I give each their freedom to them, and their children forever. I also I give bequeath and devise to the above named Ann Virginia Catharine Jane & Estline Lear Frazier the Interest arising from the sum of Five thousand \$5000 dollars which five thousand dollars shall be invested in the stock of the Bank of the Valley in Virginia, said Interest, or Dividends to be drawn by them after they attain severally the ages of Twenty 21 years or after my death.
