

Item I give and bequeath - the above mentioned sum of Five thousand dollars, principal to the children of the said Ann Virginia Catharine Lane or Eveline Lear Frazer, in case either of the said named should die, leaving children - In case either of the said named should die leaving no children it is my will the portion of the said sum be equally divided, between Elizabeth J Hunter and Mary J E Hunter daughter of my niece Rebecca S E Hunter

Item. It is my will - that the above bequest be provided for before any other.

Item I give and bequeath to Sarah R Hunter, my house & lot in Charles town - in which I lately resided, also the S. bully lot and the Magawen lot, but if she should die without issue the same shall descend to the half sister Elizabeth P. & Mary J E Hunter their heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Brother John E Lane my case of Razors, bound in Red Morocco with Ink stand, sand, wafer box &c

Item I give and bequeath to my Nephew, Joseph E Lane, son of my Brother E J Lane my silver headed cane, marked J. E. L.

Item I give, and bequeath to Andrew Kennedy Esq my shot gun

Item I give & bequeath to George Webb Esq my Bed Bedding & Bedstead, which I left with him

Item I give to my nephew George W. Webb, the silver spoons which I left with his father until called for.

Item I give and bequeath to Elizabeth J Hunter daughter of my niece Rebecca S E Hunter, my house & lot in the East end of Charlestown, the lot - containing about 14 acres, with all its appurtenances to her and her children forever.

Item I give, and bequeath to Mary J E Hunter, daughter of my niece Rebecca S E Hunter my stone stone house & lot, with all the buildings attached, situate in German street, in Shepherds town, also my lot of ground, containing about two acres of ground, adjoining the Barn lot late the property of my Brother Mr. M. Lane.

Item I give and bequeath to my niece Rebecca S E Hunter, my servant Man - William, and my pair of Carriage Horses, if William should wish to be sold, he is to choose his own master.
