Item I give and bequeath to my Nephew Willoughby L Webb the sum
of Two thousand dollars Item I give and bequeath unto Sarah Re-
becca Stanton, Elizabeth P Hunter & Mary J E. Hunter the entire
residue of my Estate, both Real and personal, including my bonds
Stock, my Bond Stock, all my Interest in the claims due from
the firm of W W & J E Kane and all my Interest in the Estate of my
brother James Kane Thomas Kane, and all my Real Estate, coming to
me from any source, also all my Bonds & Notes, Book, accounts &
Cash - I also leave to them - all and every thing - coming to me at
my death except what I have here bequeathed, but if either
of them should die, leaving no children, the portion of the one so
dying to be equally divided between the other two, and if two should
die without issue, then the survivor shall inherit the whole.
I do hereby nominate constitute, and appoint my Nephew
Willoughby L Webb, my executor, and my Niece Rebecca S E Hunter
my Executrix of this my last will & Testament.
