Exhibit C is as follows viz.

Article of agreement, between John J Woodford, of the one part and Mary F Miller of the other part, both of Clarke County & State of Kentucky. Witnesseth - That the said Mary F Miller widow and relict of William Miller, dec^d, late of said County & State being entitled to one third part of the Real, and personal Estate of the said decedent, and the personal part of the said Estate being in the possession of the executors of the said Mary F Miller, can of right draw out their hands as she may think proper, being now about to unite herself with the said J. J Woodford in marriage proposes to reserve to herself the exclusive privilege of drawing out during her life time, and of using such portion of the same from time to time, as she may think proper in presence of which the said J J Woodford hereby covenants and agrees, and contracts with the said Mary F Miller - That the exclusive Title which she now holds as relict to said William Miller dec^d shall not be lessened or abridged in any manner on account of her intermarriage with her - but hereby declares that she alone shall have the power of drawing and using of the said funds, and that her signature shall be necessary on all occasions for drawing the said funds out of the hands of said executors, and when so obtained the same is to be the exclusive property of said Mary F Miller, to be used by her, as she may think proper - hereby declaring - that her property as now owned by her, is to be exclusively appropriated, and used as she may think proper. In Testimony of a full and fair understanding of the foregoing Covenants, the said John J Woodford & Mary F Miller, have hereunto set their hands, and seals, this 30th day of Dec^r 1828. attest
