

and each one of the children as follows That is to say - The six children of my Brother William Lane, one share each, the four children of my Brother George Lane, one share each, the four children of my sister Patsy one share each, and the two children of my sister Sarah one share each, and in the event of the death of any one or more of said children leaving no issue, and have not, and do not arrive at the age of Seventy one years, or is married; then and in that event the Brothers & sisters or the Brothers, and sisters of such deceased shall receive the share of such decedent, or decedents, as the case may be, It is further my will, and desire - That my Negroes be valued by my said Executors, at a Moderate price, and that the amount be included in the aggregate of the aforesaid residue of my Estate, and that each of the legates to whom they the said Negroes chooses to go, and that one wishing to take them - at said valuation, in part of their said portion under this clause of my will, if it amounts to more, to account for the difference, the guardian of those under age shall act for them in this case, and it shall be binding on said infant, or infants 12<sup>th</sup> I do hereby appoint my husband, John Woodford, William Ritchie and John Martin executors of this my last will, or such one or more of them as shall qualify, and act as such, and in case of the death of either of said executors the survivor, or survivors of them are authorized to act as such, and carry same into effect, according to the equitable meaning thereof - I direct that there be no appraisement of my Estate; having full confidence, in my aforesaid named executors, and also authorize such one, or more of them that qualify & act, to sell my Negroes, herein before mentioned, by his or their power of attorney, for the purposes, aforesaid and further more it is my special will, and I do hereby direct & authorize, and appoint John Martin, one of my executors to receive, and to hold in Trust that portion which my nephew Newton Carter, son of my sister Sally, for the special use - and support & schooling the child, or children of the said Newton Carter at his the said John Martins discretion, and in case of the death of the said children, then the said John Martin may use it in the like manner, for the support of the said Newton and his wife, during the life time of said Newton, and his said wife 12<sup>th</sup> I give to my friend James Miller, a Secretary, that formerly belonged to two Brothers my former husbands. Miller  
13<sup>th</sup> I give my case of Bibles to Patsy Miller, daughter of James  
14<sup>th</sup> I give my Press to Sally Miller, daughter of said James  
15<sup>th</sup> I give to Melrose Lane one Burrow. To Mary Ann Lane and Alice Lane the further donation of my looking Glasses - to be divided between them, and also to Melrose Lane my framed Land Map, and my dressing Table, and Comb box & other articles of Table, and other furniture is to go and be my said husband's John Woodford.
