

the situation in which he will stand by reason of his intended marriage, and will collect and pay over from time to time as collected and received the undivided moiety, or half of the nett proceeds of the personal Estate of the said James L Lane, and to the said Thomas L Lane as Trustee for the uses and purposes herein after mentioned and will moreover pay over to said Trustee whatever money he may receive from the Maryland administration on account of the said Ann F Lane's interest and the said Thomas Lane Trustee doth hereby covenant, to and with the said Ann F Lane that he will hold in Trust for her sole, and separate use, during the continuance of her intermarriage with the said Henry Botley, all monies which he may receive from the said Henry Botley, acting as administrator as aforesaid or from any agent or attorney appointed by him, or from the administrators of the said J<sup>r</sup> Lane in Maryland, and will at any time and at all times employ & dispose of the same, or any part thereof in such manner as she may by a writing signed by her & attested by two witnesses direct either by paying the same to her or any person or persons she may in manner aforesaid appoint, or by investing it in the public funds, in the stock of incorporated Companies, either in his own name, or in the name of such person or persons as she may in manner aforesaid direct & in particular that he will out of the said trust fund, if so much shall be in his hands pay over to the children of Charles Cummins & Sarah his wife of the State of New York, the said Sarah being the sister of said Ann F. Lane, as they respectively attain the age of twenty one years the following sums to wit To Thomas Gamble Cummins the sum of one thousand dollars lawful money of the United States to Mary Gamble Cummins two thousand dollars lawful money of the United States to Jas L Lane Cummins one thousand dollars, lawful money of the United States to John Leale Cummins one thousand dollars lawful money of the United States to James Murree Cummins one thousand dollars lawful money of the United States and to Sarah Ann Cummins two thousand dollars, lawful money of the United States and if any one or more of the said children of the said Charles & Mary Cummins shall die under the age of twenty one years - leaving lawful issue, then the donation intended for the father, or mother shall go to the child and children so left, but if any or all the said children shall die under the age of twenty one years and without lawful issue, the donations done to, or donations, intended for such child, or children so dying shall not go to his her, or their survivors or personal representatives or heirs, but shall fall back into the trust fund, and if the said Ann F Lane shall depart this life without revoking the said gifts which may be done at any time by a writing signed by her, or by some person by her order in the presence of two witnesses or acknowledged by her before the witnesses - whether the said writing be Testamentary or otherwise, that the said donations are to be considered absolute subject however to a reasonable deduction, if the funds should fall short by reason of previous drafts on it made in manner aforesaid and the said Thomas Lane Trustee doth moreover covenant to comply with and perform whatever Testamentary
