N. 2519 Equity In the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The object of this suit is to procure a Decree for the sale of certain Real Estate of the late Alfred Basford, dec'd, for the payment of certain claims, which the Complainant, and others hold against the Estate of the said Alfred Basford dec'd. The Petition states, that Alfred Basford, late of Frederick County dec'd in the year eighteen hundred and forty eight, intestate, possessed of a small personal Estate, and certain Real Estate - that he left several children, to wit John Basford, Ellen Basford Eliza Basford Henry Basford, Charlotte Basford Susan Basford George Basford Alfred Basford, and Adam Basford That John Ellen Eliza and Henry are twenty-one years of age and the rest of said Children, are under the age of twenty one years and that all of them are still living

The Petition further states - That the said Alfred Basford dec'd was at the time of his death indebted to the said Complainant in a certain sum of money on a note, and also unto several other persons in various sums of money, the Petition further states - that administration of all and singular the personal property of said Alfred Basford dec'd was granted unto a certain Abraham Ziegenbeger, by the Orphans Court of Frederick County aforesaid; That said personal property has been fully settled up and paid out, as far as the same would reach, in discharge of the said debts of said deceased, but that the same was greatly insufficient, to pay in full the debts of said dec'd, and prays that a Decree may be passed for the sale of so much of the said Real Estate as may be necessary to supply the deficiency of said personal Estate, in the payment of said debts, or claims. The Petition further states, that the said Ellen Basford, has removed from the State of Maryland & now resides some where in the State of Virginia.

It is therefore this Thirtieth day of September 1853 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County - sitting as a Court of Equity, Ordered that the Complainant cause a Copy of this Order, to be inserted, in some Newspaper printed in Frederick, for one month prior to the eighth day of November next, thereby warning, and giving notice to the said Ellen Basford the said absent defendant, to be & appear before this Court, in person or by Solicitor, on or before the Tenth day of February 1854 then and there to answer the said bill of Complaint, and show cause if any she has why a Decree should not pass as prayed
