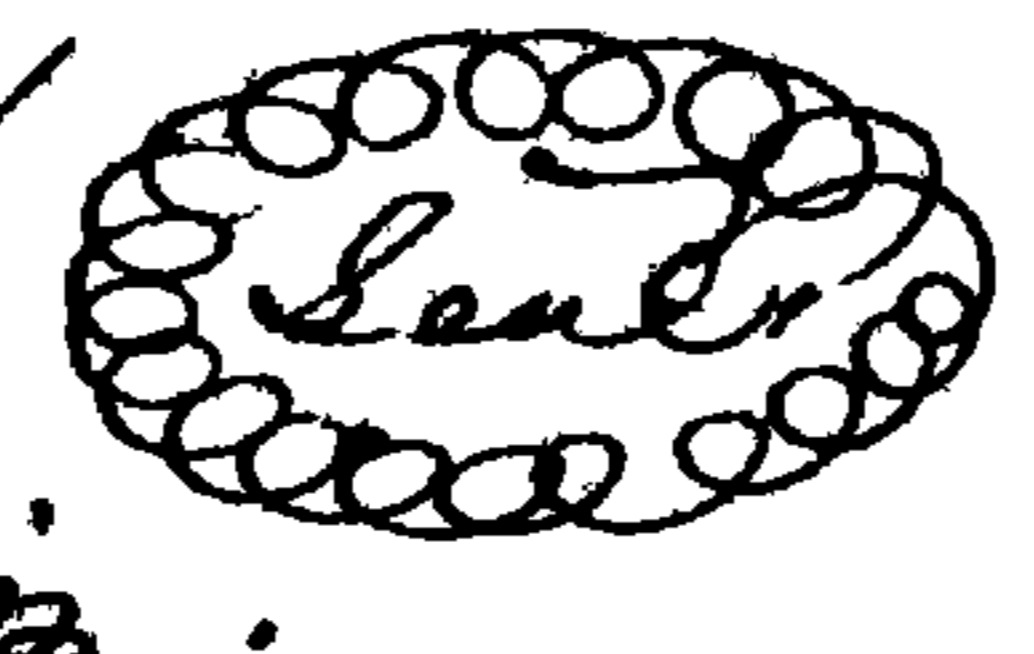


It is thereupon ordered by the Court this 15 day of March. 1852 that the Executor aforesaid dispose of said Real Estate, on the following terms One third of the purchased money to be paid, on the day of sale or on the ratification thereof, and the remaining two thirds, in two equal, annual payments, bearing Interest from the day of sale the first yearing to be paid by hand Bills, put up in the most public places in the neighborhood, and in said newspapers, at least three weeks previous to said sale, giving notice of the time place, and the terms thereof.

To the Hon. the Judges of the Orphans Court of Frederick County The undersigned Executor of John Mc Elfresh late of Frederick County dec'd? begs leave to Report, that by virtue of the Authority vested in the last will of said deceased, and in obedience to an Order of your Honorable Court I did sell at private sale, after having given the notice required by said Order, the Real Estate of said dec'd Consisting in part, as follows. a Tract of Land known as part of Hobbs purchase being the same place, sold to John and Charles Wood containing two hundred, and fifty acres, more or less for the gross sum, of Two thousand four hundred, and fifteen dollars & also a tract of Land containing Ninety seven acres, more or less part of Hobbs purchase sold to Samuel Taylor, for the sum of \$950 for acre, and making in the aggregate \$921 50 and also a Lot of Land lying near Bartholomew Water Station, containing about six acres, more or less, sold to William Joshua Cain for the sum of Forty three dollars and fifty cents. One third to be paid on the day of sale, or ratification of the sale, and the remaining two thirds, in two equal annual payments, bearing Interest from the day of sale, the whole amount of the sale in the aggregate, amounting to the sum of 33804 all which is most Respectfully submitted.

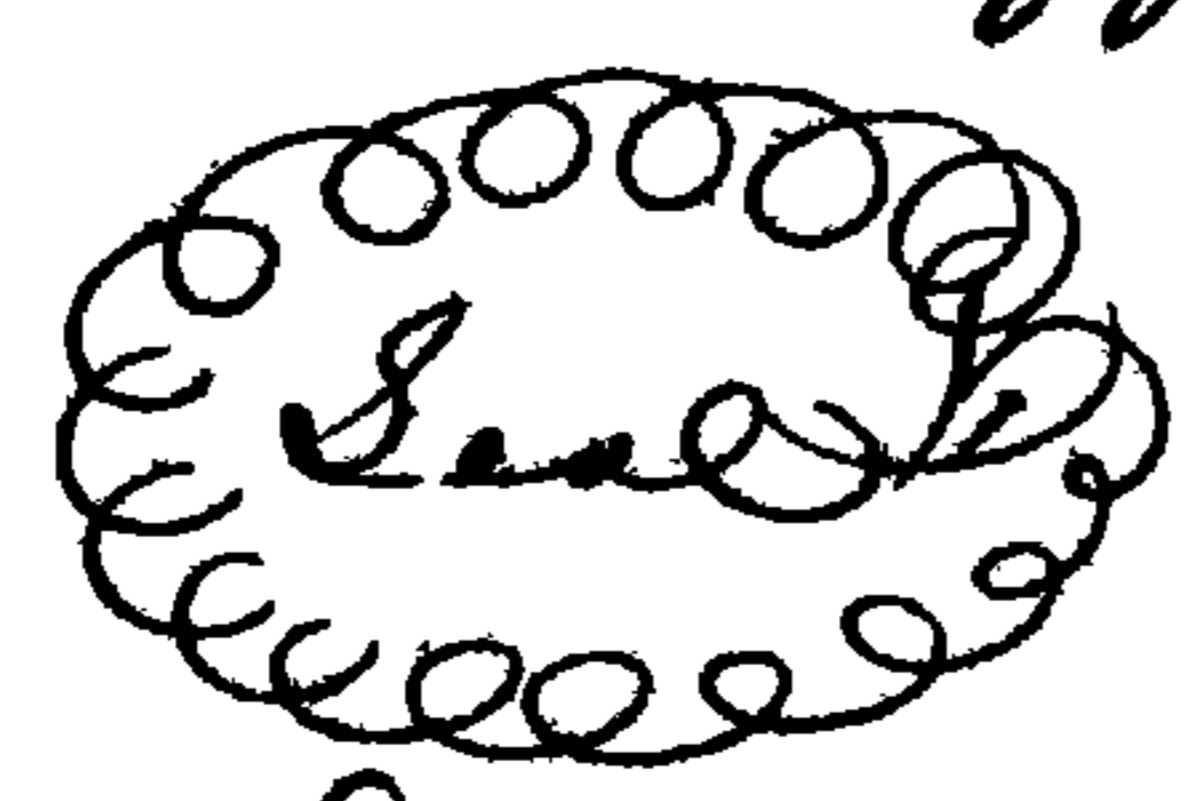
