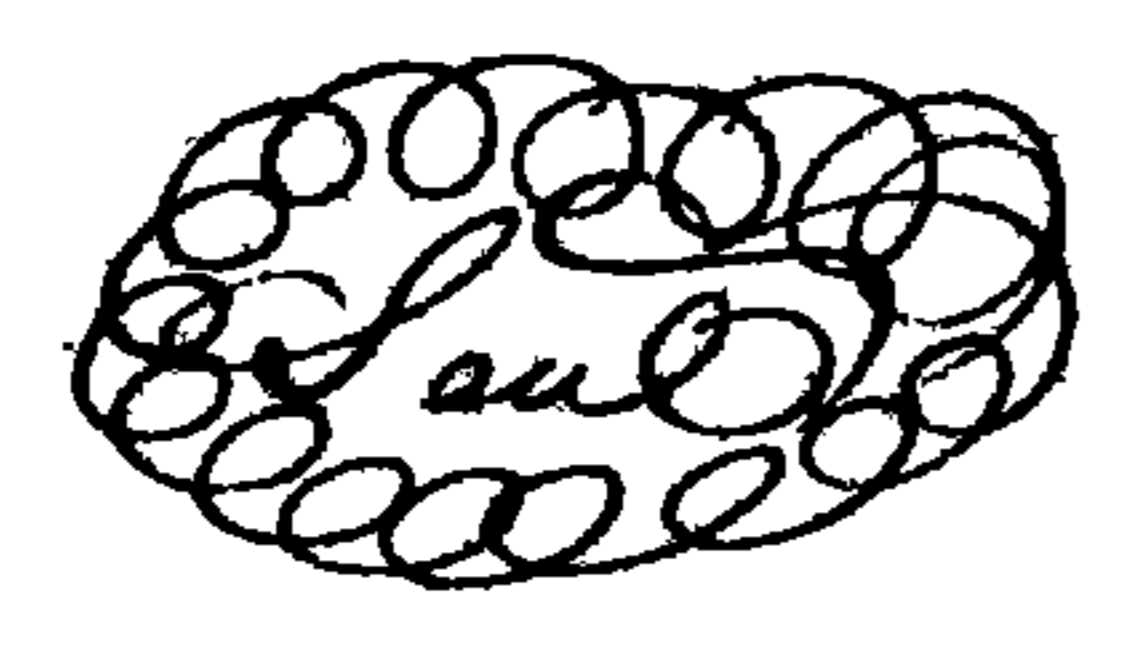

Thereupon the following Decree was passed.
 Henrietta Morris on } No 2568. Equity. In the Circuit Court for
 Petition } Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity
 July Term. 1854

This case being submitted to the Court, upon the Petition & exhibits
 which were read & considered, and the Court being satisfied
 that the prayer of the said Petition ought to be granted. It is
 thereupon this 26th day of July, eighteen hundred and fifty four
 by the said Circuit Court, for Frederick County, sitting as a Court
 of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, ordered adjudged
 and decreed that Henrietta Morris of Frederick County, be &
 he is hereby appointed Trustee in the place and stead of Wm
 Morris dec^d. the executor, constituted and appointed by John
 M^r Elfresh dec^d. in his Testament, and last will, who died be
 fore having fully executed and finished the trust reposed in
 him and that the said Henrietta Morris, as such Trustee
 is hereby authorized, and empowered to fully complete and
 finish the Trust reposed in the said William Morris by vir-
 tue of the Testament, and last will of said John M^r Elfresh
 dec^d. in relation to the sale of the Real Estate of said Testator
 which was left unfinished by the said William Morris, at the
 time of his death, and to do all such acts as may be necessary,
 to be done, to finish and complete said Trust, and make, and
 execute in due form of law, all necessary Deeds of Conveyances
 to the purchasers of the Real Estate of which the said John M^r
 Elfresh, dec^d seized, and the owner, in as full and ample a manner
 as the said William Morris could have done, in his life time, &
 and that all such acts Deeds & doing of the said Trustee in re-
 lation to the completing, and finishing said Trust shall be good
 and valid, to all intents, and purposes. And it is further ordered
 adjudged, and decreed that the said Henrietta Morris, the said
 Trustee shall first file in this Court, with the Clerk thereof,
 her Bond to the State of Maryland executed by herself, with
 good security, to be approved agreeable to law in the penalty,
 of Three thousand Dollars. Conditioned for the faithful dis-
 charge of the Trust reposed in her by this Decree, or which
 may be reposed in her by any future order or Decree in the prem-
 ises she shall then proceed to the faithful execution of the said
 Trust hereby reposed in her, according to the true intent & meaning
 of the Testament, and last will of the said John M^r Elfresh
 dec^d and any future order of this Court, in the premises
