



Whereas by a Decree of the Circuit Court, for Frederick County sitting in Equity, bearing date the 26 day of July 1854 and passed in a cause in the said Court, and numbered 3568, on the Equity Docket the said Samuel Morris was appointed Trustee, in the place and stead of William Morris dec'd. the Executor Com-stituted and appointed by John M. Elfrisk dec'd. in his Testament and last will who died before having fully executed & finished the trust reposed in him, and that Samuel Morris as such Trustee, was authorized, and empowered by said Decree to fully complete, and finish the trust reposed in the said William Morris by virtue of the Testament and last will of the said John M. Elfrisk dec'd. and to do all such acts, as may be necessary to be done to finish, and complete said Trust, and make & execute, under form of Law all necessary Deeds of Conveyance to the purchasers of the Real Estate of which the said John M. Elfrisk died seignior and the owner, in as full and ample a manner as said William Morris, could have done on his life time Now the Condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden Steu-rectus & Morris, do and shall well and faithfully perform the trust reposed in her by said Decree, or which may be reposed in her, by any future Decree or order in the premises, then the above obligation, to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in Law.
