 loss in the premises by the strict rules of Common law, & only relief
 able in a Court of Equity, where matters of this nature are properly
 Cognizable and to the end that the Defendants herein after named may
 upon their several Corporal Oath, true and perfect answers make
 to the matters, and things herein charged, as if they were specifically
 interrogated thereto, and that the aforesaid Real Estate, or so much
 thereof, as may be necessary for the payment of debts, may be sold -
 and that your Complainant may have all such other or further
 relief in the premises, as may be consistent with Equity and
 the nature of the case, May it please your Honor to grant unto
 your Complainant, an Order of Publication, giving notice to the said
 James H Buckey - Margaret H C Buckey John Ray & Sarah Ellen -
 Ray, his wife, Caroline Susan Buckey George Adam Buckey, Ann
 Rebecca Buckey, Mary Elizabeth Buckey, John Edward Buckey and
 Martha Medora Buckey, who are now residents of the State of Mary-
 land, as before stated of the substance, and object of this Bill, and
 warning them to be and appear in this Court, in person, or
 by solicitor, on or before a designated day, to answer the premises,
 and show cause, if any they have, why a Decree ought not to pass
 as prayed, and also a writ of Subpoena, in the usual form, against
 George William Buckey administrator of Jacob Buckey dead and to the
 Sheriff of Frederick County to be directed, Commanding him to be &
 appear in this Court, at some certain day to be therein fixed, to answer
 the premises, and obey, and perform such Decree as may be
 passed thereon
