Whereas by a Decree of the Grant Court, for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity bearing date the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1854 and passed in a cause therein pending, in which James M. Starland and others were Complainants, and Moses Ansons & others, were respondents, being No 2504, Equity, in said Court the said Moses Ansons was appointed Trustee to make sale of the Real Estate mentioned in the said proceedings, now the condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound Moses Ansons, do & shall well and faithfully discharge the duties, imposed upon, & the Trust reposed in him by said Decree, or which may be reposed in him by any future order, or Decree in the premises, then the above obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in Law.
