represents to your Honors That your orators & oratrices, and
Mary Collins, Elizabeth Collins Anneth Collins and Ellen -
Collins all of Frederick County, are jointly seized, in fee Simple,
of a Tract, or parcel of Land, situated in Frederick County, called
"Stobson's Choice" and containing One Hundred and Fifty acres,
more or less, the Title to which will appear to your Honors upon
reference to the last will and Testament of Henry Ebury the uncle
of your orators, and oratrices, and the above named defendants
wherein it is claimed among other things as follows. I devise to -
Henry Collins, son in law to my brother Philip & Elizabeth -
Collins his wife, during their lives respectively the Tract of
Land, on which I now live, subject to the encumbrances afove
said, and on their decease, the same is to become the right &
Estate of all their children, in equal proportions, and of their
heirs and assigns forever said Tract of Land being called
Stobson's choice. That Henry Collins & Elizabeth Collins his
wife the father & mother of your orators & oratrices, and the
above named defendants, and the cetera que sic named and
