May it please your Honors to grant to your orators, and oratrices, the writ of Subpoena, against the said Mary Collins Elizabeth Collins Aseneth Collins & Ellen Collins of Frederick County - Commanding them, and each of them, to appear in this Court, at some certain day, to be named therein to answer the premises, and obey, and perform such Decree as may be passed therein and as an duty bound, your orators & oratrices do will ever pray & so forth.

In the name of God amen I Henry Ebert, of Frederick County, and State of Maryland, make, and ordain this my last will, and Testament, as follows It is my will that all my just debts, and funeral charges be paid by my Executor hereafter named. Item It is my will, That my wife, Elizabeth shall keep possession of my dwelling House, and all my household furniture; the garden, the lot of ground, back of the dwelling House and all of my stock of every description, during her life Also one third of the produce raised on my farm, as wheat Rye Oats Indian Corn Hay Flax, and Potatoes The wheat & Rye to be thrashed, and delivered, at some convenient mill, and the flour and bran, brought home to her, by my Executor, or other person, who may occupy my said Farm. She is also privileged to keep a Cow, and Sheep, and three Hogs on my said farm as long as she may live, to be furnished with fuel, for firing, delivered at the door of her dwelling, cut into lengths proper for either stove or Fire place, as she may require it; Also with Rails, when wanted, to keep the fence round the above mentioned Lot in repair, &
