Whereas, John Kenzer late of Frederick County died, by his last will & testament bearing date on the 19th of March 1846 authorize and devise that I might take the mansion farm as it is designated in the last will and testament of the said John Kenzer as the appraisement of three respectable disinterested persons named by the Orphans Court of Frederick County, and whereas the said Court appointed Jacob Saylor, Abraham Grabbell & Suratt D. Warfield to appraise the same, who after being duly qualified proceeded to value the same and made a return of said appraisement to the said Court on the 26th day of May 1848 Now therefore this is to certify to your Hon^r body that I elect to take the same containing 162 acres of land more or less at 58 dollars per acre amounting in the aggregate to the sum of 9396 dollars
