This Indenture - made this 25 day of  
 April 1846. between Daniel Mann - trustee of Frederick Summers of  
 Frederick County, State of Maryland of the one part, & Magdalen  
 Shoemaker of said County, and State of the other part: whereas by a  
 deed of Trust, executed by the said Frederick Summers - for the benefit  
 of his creditors, bearing date November 14 1844 on which deed of  
 trust the said Daniel Mann was appointed Trustee to make sale of the  
 property in said deed mentioned, and herein particularly described and  
 conveyed and whereas the said Daniel Mann Trustee in pursuance  
 of said Deed did on the 28 day of October 1846. sell & dispose of to the  
 said Magdalen Shoemaker the Property herein after described & conveyed  
 for the sum of Three Hundred and Twenty five dollars current money,  
 and whereas the purchase money for the said property and promises, having  
 been fully paid and satisfied, the said Daniel Mann doth agree to execute  
 these presents, in pursuance of the power vealed in him in and by the said  
 deed of trust Now this Indenture Witnesseth - that the said Daniel  
 Mann, for and in Consideration of the premises, and also of Five Dollars  
 current money, in hand paid by the said Magdalen Shoemaker to the said  
 Daniel Mann, in hand paid, at and before the sealing & delivery of these  
 presents, the receipt of which he doth hereby acknowledge, and himself to  
 be therewith fully satisfied, Contented and paid, the said Daniel Mann  
 hath bargained and sold aliened and enfeoffed, and by these presents  
 doth give grant bargain and sell, alien enfeoff release, convey, & confirm,  
 unto the said Magdalen Shoemaker, her heirs, and assigns, all that  
 part of a Tract, or parcel of Land, Called Shoemakers tracks, Situate and  
 lying in Frederick County aforesaid, and contained with the following  
 metes & bounds Courses and Distances, to wit: Beginning at a Red Oak  
 standing in a hollow between two small hills, and about eight perches  
 from, and on the South west side of a small Branch, leading from  
 a Spring near the head of said hollow, and runs into Gunstone run a  
 Branch of the Catock Creek, and running thence S 74° W 44 ps to a  
 Chestnut Oak marked with nine notches then South Fifty two degrees,  
 west forty nine perches to the end of 47 perches on the line of the Resurvey  
 on Bear Swamp then with the ant lines thereof reversed North forty  
 seven perches North Twenty one degrees East Fifty ps North Eighty three  
 degrees East Forty two ps South Fifty eight degrees East Thirty six perches,  
 to the end of four perches on the fourteenth line of said Resurvey on  
 Bear Swamp, it also being the end of 22 ps on the Sixth line of a tract  
 of Land, called Adams Hill" Then with said line reversed south five degrees,
