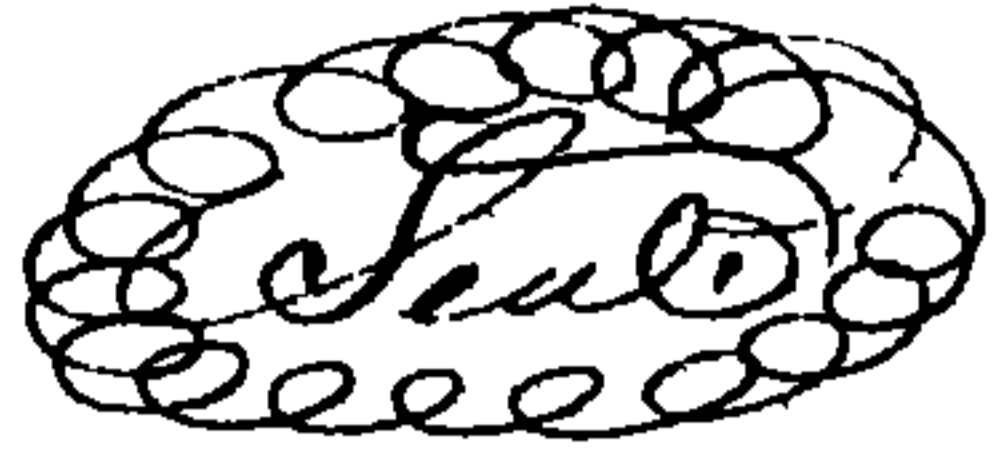

my Insolvent debtors, and its several Supplements William Poal was by one the subscribers one of the Justices of the Orphan's Court of Frederick County, appointed Trustee for the benefit of the creditors of said William Abrecht and whereas the said William Abrecht hath conveyed, and delivered into the said all his property - Real personal, and mixed, the necessary wearing apparel, & bedding of himself and family excepted and whereas the said Trustee - has executed a bond, to the State of Maryland by one approved - for 500. dollars current money, for the faithful discharge of his - trust, and certified his possession of said applicants property - as required by law It is therefore hereby ordered that the said - Trustee collect the debts, due said debtor, and sell & convey for Cash, after giving due notice of the time, place, and manner of sale the property conveyed to him as Trustee, and that he or vend the proceeds of such Collections, and sales after deducting - 5 per cent, allowed him, for his Commission, & after satisfy- ing all Judgments, incumbrances, and liens, among the said - Creditors, agreeably to their respected claims, according to the - true intent and meaning of the aforesaid act of assembly, and - its several Supplements.
