This Indenture - made this 19th day of October 1821. Between John P. Ramsburg of Fredrick County, in the State of Maryland of the one part, and Jacob Waskey of the County & State aforesaid of the other - Witnesseth - That the said John P. Ramsburg for y^e Consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred Dollars, Current money of the United States, to him in hand paid, by said Jacob Waskey, before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof he the said John P. Ramsburg doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain sell, alien enfeoff & confirm unto the said Jacob Waskey, his heirs & assigns, all the parts of the Tract of Land " called " Castle Henry " and Lot N. 13, lying in Fredrick County aforesaid, Beginning for the out lines of the whole of the parts of said Lands hereby intended to be conveyed, at the beginning of that Original Tract of Land called " Pleasant Plains " running thence N 67 1/2° W 90 1/2 ps to a stone planted, S 39° W 20 ps to a stone formerly planted S 38 1/2° E 40 ps to a stone formerly planted S 60° W 12 ps to a stone formerly planted, S 27° W 40 ps. to a Locust stake at the Beginning of the deed from Lewis Lanfer to Peter Mangelt then with the line of said Deed 2 courses S 27° W 5 ps to a Stake - S 75° E 53 ps to a Stake, then N 26 1/4° E 41 ps of 2/10 of a perch to a Locust Stake S 75° E 44 6/10 ps to a Stone heap. on the last end of a deed - from George Stanger to Peter Mangelt Dec^d for Forty nine acres, and twenty ps of Land, then by a straight line to the Beginning containing 4 1/2 acres of Land more or less Together with all and singular the buildings, Improvements, hereditaments & appurtenances, whatsoever therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversions & remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and all the Estate, right Title & Interest whatsoever of him the said John P.
