


 - Eockbt, of November 1839. This Indenture, made this 8.<sup>th</sup> day of November, in  
 the year of our Lord 1839 between James Castle son of Frederick County  
 in the State of Maryland, of the one part, and Jacob Wastey of the  
 said County, and State of the other part; Witnesseth that the said  
 James Castle for and in Consideration of the sum of Two hundred  
 and three dollars and seventy five cents, current money of the United  
 States to him in hand paid by the said Jacob Wastey before the seal-  
 ing, and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he the said  
 James Castle doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained  
 sold, aliened, conveyed & confirmed, and by these presents doth grant  
 bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Jacob Wastey  
 his heirs & assigns all the following described piece, or parcel of Land  
 lying and being in the County of State aforesaid Viz part of Lot N<sup>o</sup> 21 it being  
 part of a tract called "Auldred" Reserving for the same a Stone plan-  
 ted at the end of 69 3/4 ps. on the South, or S 53 1/2' E 110 ps. line of the whole  
 Lot N<sup>o</sup> 21. as aforesaid & running thence by and with said line S 53 1/2' E -  
 40 ps to a Stone formerly planted, at the end thereof, still by & with the
