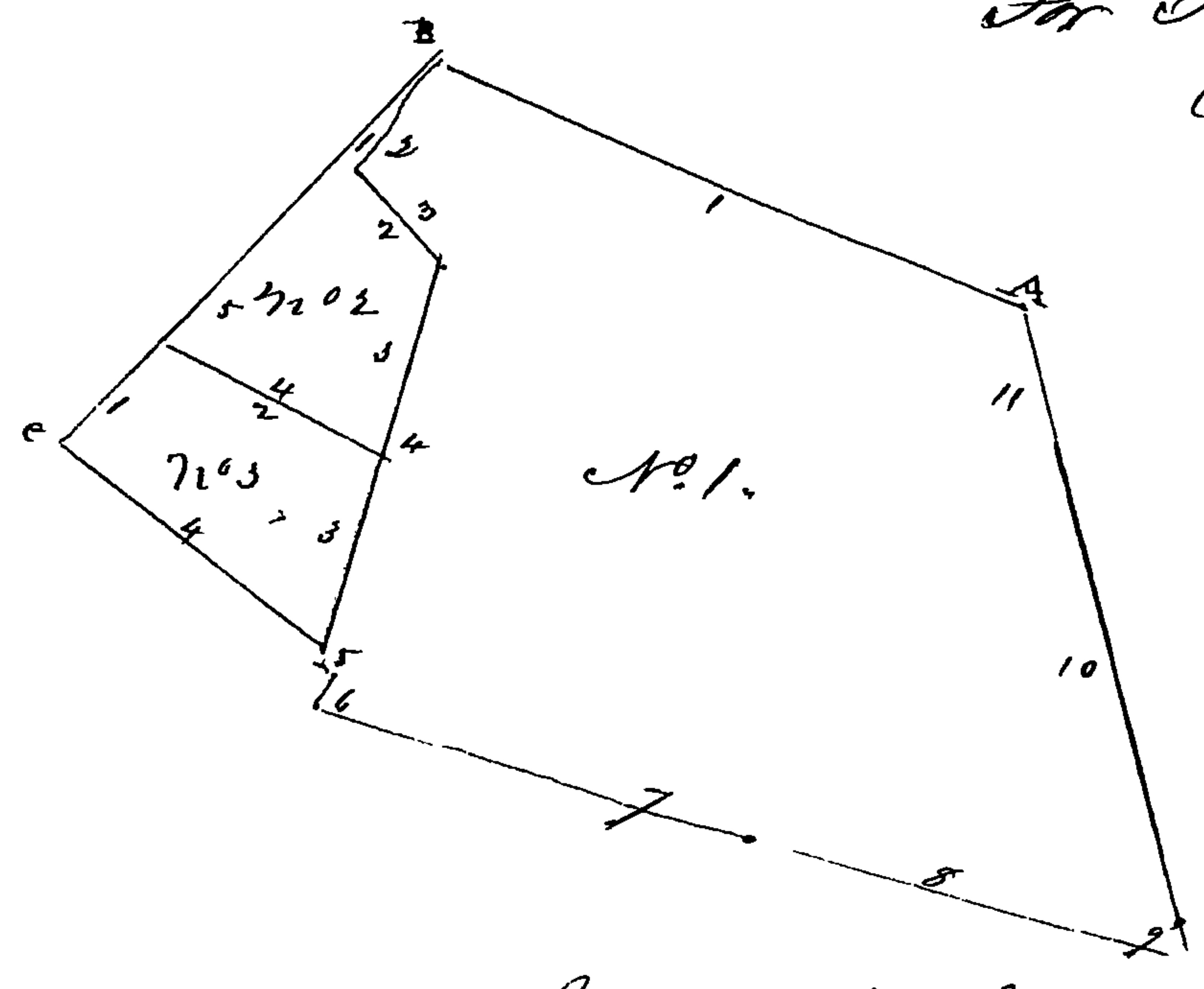

Beginning for the out lines of No. 1 at a large stone standing, at the beginning of that Original Tract of Land "called" Pleasant Plains it also being the Beginning of a deed from John P Ramsburg to Jacob Wasky dated the 19 October 1821. and running thence with said deed the three following courses & distances by 1/2 degrees, allowed for Variation N 67 1/2° W 90 1/2 ps to a stone S 39° W 20 ps to a stone S 38 1/2° E 18 1/2 ps to a Stake then S 17 1/2° W 59 4/5 ps. to a stake at the end of 1 3/5 ps on the 5<sup>th</sup> line of a deed from Jacob Getzenanner of Jacob to Jacob Wasky dated Decr 14 1822. and with said line reversed by an allowance of 1/2 degrees for Variation S 49 1/2° E 1 3/5 ps to a stake, at the end of the fifth line of the above said deed from John P Ramsburg, to Jacob Wasky, then with said deed the two following courses, & distances to wit by same allowance S 27° W 5 ps to a stake S 75° E 53 ps. to a stake standing at the Beginning of a deed from Richard Wimpfley to the aforesaid Jacob Wasky, dated September 9 1820. then with said Deed by same allowance S 75° E 75 3/5 ps to a large Stone planted N 12 1/2° W 10 1/2 ps. N 12 1/2° W 35 1/2 ps to a stone, then N 10 1/2° W 48 1/2 ps to the first mentioned beginning, and containing 59 acres one Rod and 28 1/2 acres of land Beginning for the out lines of No. 2 at a wood lot, at a stone standing at the end of the first line of a Deed from John P Ramsburg, to Jacob Wasky dated, October 19 1821 it also being the Beginning of a deed from Jacob Getzenanner of Jacob to Jacob Wasky, dated December 14 1822, and running with last recited deed the two following courses, & distances, by 1/2° allowed for Variation S 39° W 20 ps to a stone S 38 1/2° E 18 1/2 ps to a Stake, then S 17 1/2° W 29 3/10 ps to a Stake N 60° W 36 3/5 ps. to a Stake standing at the end of 20 ps on the closing line of the aforesaid deed from Jacob Getzenanner of Jacob to Jacob Wasky, then with said line N 46° E 56 3/10 ps to the first
