Exhibit At the request of Leonard Reddick, the following deed is Recorded - A 11<sup>th</sup> day of February 1853 This Indenture, made this twenty ninth day of August, in the year Eighteen hundred, and thirty two, between Samuel Repp, and Elizabeth his wife of Jefferson Township Montgomery County, and State of Ohio - of the one part, and Leonard Reddick of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland of the other part: Witnesses, that the said parties of the first part, for & in consideration of the sum of one thousand, and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Leonard Reddick, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, and sold, aliened enfeoffed & confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Leonard Reddick his heirs and assigns forever, the whole of an uninclosed sixth part of Two hundred and fifty two acres of Land, more or less lying in the vicinity of Liberty town, Frederick County Maryland being the whole of the Real Estate of which Leonard Reddick Sen late of Frederick County was seized, the said sixth part, hereby intended to be conveyed, containing about forty two acres of Land, Together with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and all the Estate right Title & Interest, Trust, property -
