Kuhn, the absent Defendant to be and appear in this least, in person, or by Solicitor on or before a certain day to answer the premises & to shew cause if any he have, why a Decree shall not pass as prayed, which in duty bound your orators & oraturges will ever pray &c.

That is to say  
 First and principally - I Commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named & after my debts & funeral charges are paid I devise, and bequeath as follows I give, and bequeath to my wife Catharine E. all the personal property she brought here.
