

I do therefore empower my Executors aforesaid, with full power to make deeds of Conveyances and all things necessary for the final closing of my Estate, as well as I might or could do were I personally present In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 31st Day of May in the year of our Lord 1841  Zebulon Kuhn.




