Will In the name of God Amen, I Catharine Weaver of Frederick town Maryland,
being feeble in health but of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make
and publish this my last will and testament, in manner and form following viz,
I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it me, and my body to
the earth to be decently buried by my executor hereinafter named, and after all my
Just debts and funeral charges are paid I dispose of my estate as follows viz,
I give and bequeath unto Mary Catharine Logue, and George Anna Virginia Logue
children of Lewis and Mary Logue, all my household and kitchen furniture, and all
monies I may have on hand and due me on note bond or otherwise at the time of my
death to them the said Mary Catharine and George Anna Virginia Logue share & share alike.
I hereby order and direct my Executor to have prepared and put up over the grave of
myself and my sister Mary Henry suitable Tombstones of Marble, and to pay for the
same out of the proceeds of my estate left at my death - I also give and bequeath
unto William Samuel Logue, son of Lewis Logue and Mary Logue the sum of one
hundred dollars bearing interest from the time of my death the said sum to remain
in the hands of his father Lewis Logue and to be accounted for by him, when
the said William Samuel Logue shall have arrived at lawful age. - I hereby
order and direct my Executor to sell at public or private sale, as he shall deem best,
my two houses and lots of ground belonging to the same, and to make & execute
to the purchaser or purchasers of the same good and sufficient deeds, and the
proceeds arising therefrom to be distributed as follows, after paying for the Tomb Stone
to be placed over the graves of myself and sister and all debts and funeral charges
paid and the sum of one hundred dollars to William Samuel Logue, the remainder
or balance of the proceeds of the sale of the two houses and lots of ground aforesaid -
I give and bequeath unto Mary Logue wife of Lewis Logue and Margaret Bartges
widow of Mathias E Bartges deceased, to them and their heirs share and share alike
And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my friend Lewis Logue to be sole Executor
of this my last will and testament, revoking and annulling all former wills by me
heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will &
testament In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th
day of September in the year of our Lord 1851

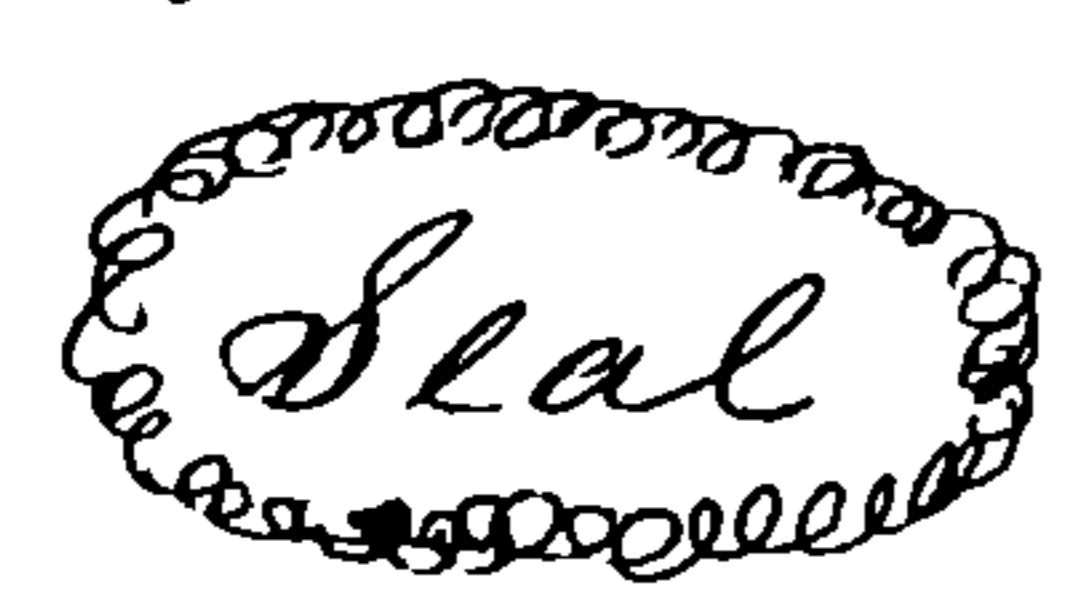
