To the Honorable Mason Nelson Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting in Equity The Petition of Egra Cramer next friend of John Adams, late of Frederick County deceased respectfully shews - That one Jacob Adams in his lifetime was seized and possessed of a lot, or parcel of land, lying in Frederick County, containing three quarters of an acre more or less which was conveyed to the said Jacob Adams by Samuel Deollis by deed herewith filed marked exhibit N^o 1. and that the said land on the death of the said Jacob Adams has descended to the said Infant, who is his only child and heir at Law. and also - That Elizabeth Adams, late of said County died seized of a lot or parcel of land situate in said County, and containing about three quarters of an acre which was part of the land conveyed to said Elizabeth Adams by Jacob Adams, by deed herewith filed marked Exhibit N^o 2. which said land has descended to said Infant, who is the only heir at Law of said Elizabeth, and that the said two lots of land lie adjoining to each other, and compose one parcel, and that the said John Adams is an Infant, under twenty one years of age and resides in Frederick County and your Petitioner prays that the said Exhibits N^o 1 & 2 may be taken as part of this his Petition - Your Petitioner further shews to your Honor that it will be for the Interest, and advantage of said Infant, that the said land should be sold, and the proceeds thereof invested for the use, and benefit of said Infant. Your Petitioner therefore prays your Honor that the said land may be sold, and that a Commission may issue to three Freeholders of Frederick County to determine whether it will be for the Interest of said Infant that said land shall be sold, and to report thereon to your Honor, and that a Subpoena may be issued, directed to the said infant. Commanding him on a certain day thereon to be named to be and appear, in your Honorable Court, then & there to answer the premises, and your petitioner will ever pray &c
