 Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, heir at law of John
 Devilbiss (of Casper) late of said County deceased of the one part, and
 Jacob Adams of the County and State aforesaid of the other part.
 Witnesseth. That said Samuel Deolbess for and in Consideration -
 of the sum of Fifteen dollar current money, to him in hand paid
 by the said Jacob Adams at or before the Ensigning and delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof he the said Samuel Deolbess
 doth hereby acknowledge, hath given granted bargained sold, re-
 leased conveyed, and Confirmed, and by these presents doth give
 grant bargain sold, alien released conveyed and Confirmed, unto him
 the said Jacob Adams, his heirs and assigns, all that Lot or
 parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the County & State afores-
 said, being part of a Tract of land called "Ogles necessary Compact")
 which was formerly conveyed by a certain Alexander Ogles to John
 Deolbess aforesaid for four hundred and forty acres by deed bearing
 date, on or about the Twenty first day of July eighteen hundred -
 and seven - beginning for the lot or parcel of land hereby intended to
 be conveyed, at a Stone now planted at the end of Forty rods & one
 quarter perches on the Seventeenth line of the whole tract aforesaid, and
 with said line South fifteen degrees, West Ten and three quarter
 perches to a Stone originally planted at the end of said line, then with
 the Seventy first line of the whole Tract aforesaid, South Fifty Three -
 degrees, east Ten perches, and eight tenths of a perch to a Stone now
 planted thence North Nineteen and a half degrees east ten perches &
 three quarters of a perch to a Stone now planted thence with a
