the State of Maryland, being sick, and weak of body, but of sound
and disposing mind memory, and understanding, Considering the
certainty of death, and the uncertainty of the time thereof, do then
freely make, and publish this my last will and Testament, in
manner, and form following - that is to say - I devise & bequeath
as follows Item I give and bequeath as follows Item I give &
bequeath to my brother William all my Interest in the Tannery
which we hold in partnership in the State of Virginia That is
to say - I give and bequeath to him all that I have invested in
said Tannery as his Partner. Subject to the adjustment of the
Partnership - Item I direct my Executor to dispose of at Public
or Private sale, all my property of personal nature in Maryland,
and after collecting all moneys owing to me, and the payment
of all my debts, and funeral expences to distribute the residue as
follows that is to say Item I give and bequeath to the American
Tract Society - Two hundred Dollars. Item I give & bequeath
to the Board of Domestic Missions of the German Reformed Church -
one hundred Dollars. Item I give, and bequeath to the Board of
Foreign Missions of the German Reformed Church, one hundred
Dollars Item - I give and bequeath the rest & residue of my Estate
to be Equally divided between my brother William & my four
Sisters Eliza intermarried with John Vickum, Mary Aunt
wife of John Davis Catharine wife of James Baughen & Ann
Troville share and share alike. Item It is my will & I hereby di-
rect that my Executor do not sell any of the Household goods,
now in the House occupied by me in Emmittsburg, except he
should choose to do so.

And lastly I do hereby constitute, and appoint my brother Wil-
liam, to be sole executor of this my last will and Testament
