


State of Maryland Frederick County Set On this 9<sup>th</sup> May 1839 personally appeared before us the Subscribers, two Justices of the peace, for the County aforesaid William Greager, party grantor to the within Indenture, or Instrument of writing, and acknowledged the same to be his act & deed, and the Land and premises therein conveyed - or intended to be conveyed, to be the right and Estate of William Miller Sen party grantee therein named, his heirs & assigns forever according to the true intent & meaning of the same, and the acts of assembly in such case made and provided also at the same time and place before us personally appeared Elizabeth Greager, wife of the said William Greager party grantor to the within deed & acknowledged the same & that she relinquished, and released all her right & claim of dower, unto the said described Land hereby granted, bargained and sold, to the said William Miller Sen therein mentioned, and the said Elizabeth Greager being at the same time by us privately examined apart from, & out of the hearing of her said husband, do declare that she made her acknowledgment of the same willingly & freely & without being induced thereto by fear or threats of or ill usage by her said husband or by fear of his displeasure. we also certify, that we are acquainted with the said parties, and know them to be persons that have signed & sealed the same


