 act in the premises shall execute a Bond to the State of Maryland, in the penalty
 of six thousand dollars current money with two or more Sureties to be approved
 by the Clerk Conditioned, for the Faithful Discharge of his duty as said Trustee
 of the person and Estate, Real and Personal of said Zachariah Miller, for the delivery
 up of the Property of The said Zachariah whenever so required to do by the Court -
 for the rendering of an account of all his receipts & expenditures as Trustee
