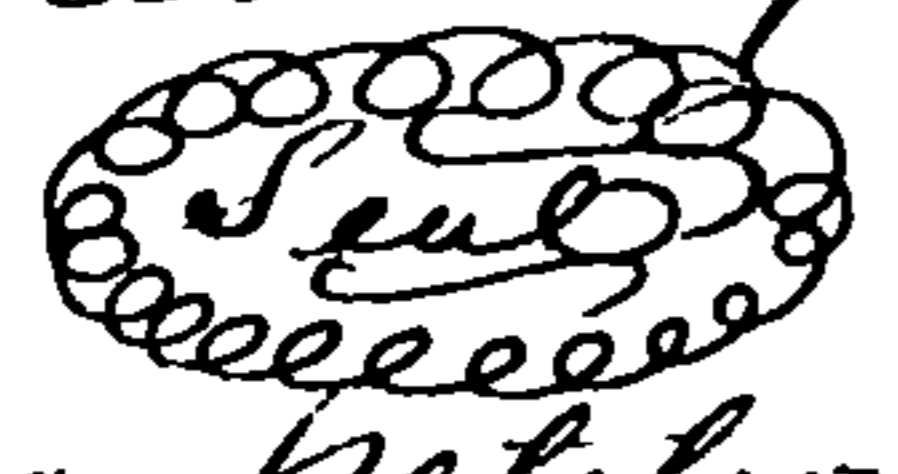

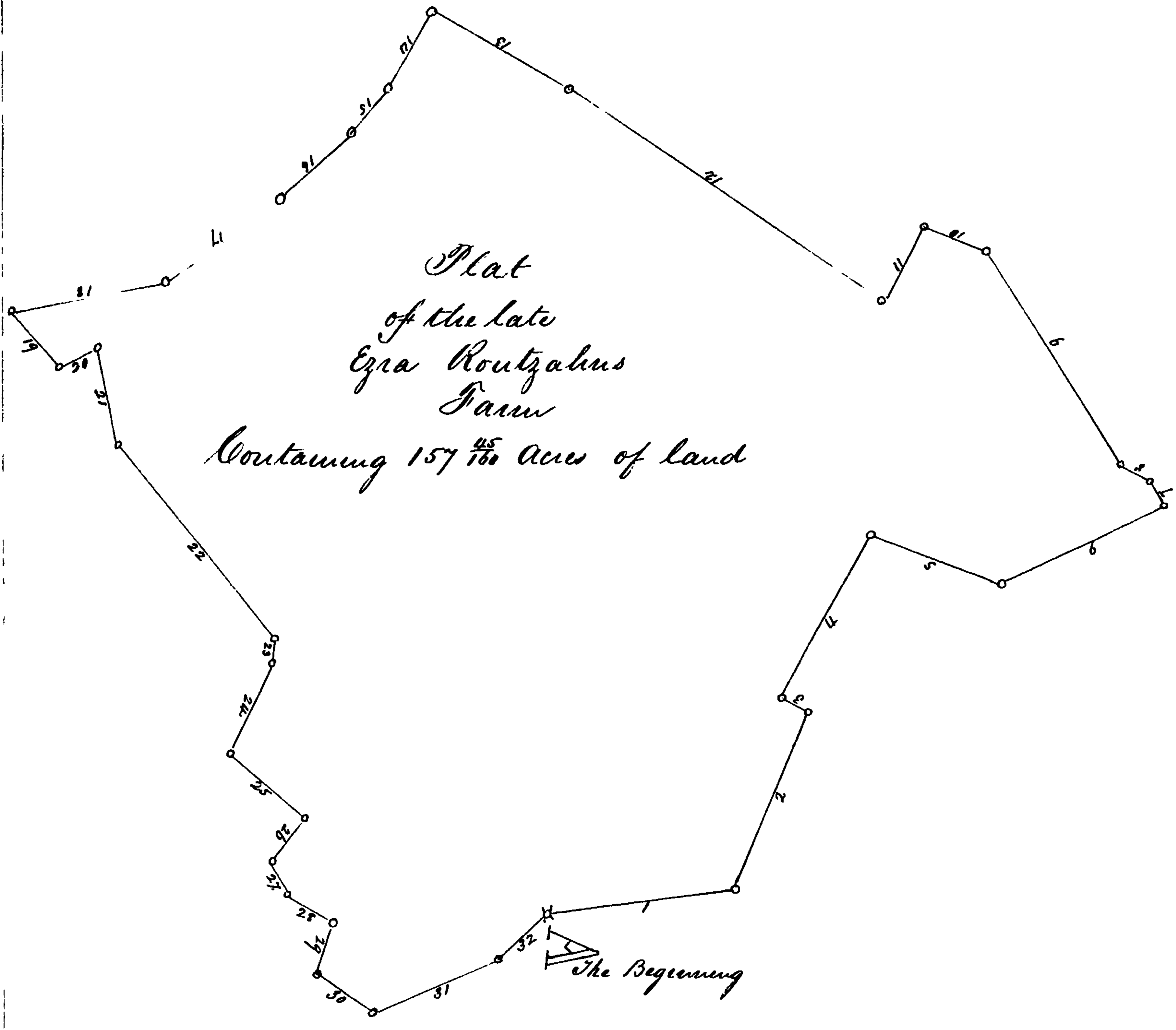
The following petition was filed 20 April 1854.

To the Hon. Madison Nelson - Judge

of the Circuit Court for Frederick County. Sitting as a Court of Equity The Petition
of Joseph Routzahn Trustee, and Daniel Mann the purchaser sheweth - That
on the 31st day of December 1853 Your Petitioner Joseph Routzahn as Trustee sold the
Lands described in No 2490 Equity to Daniel Mann as containing One Thousand &
Seventy six acres of Land at and for the sum of Seventy five Dollars & sixteen Cents per
acre making an aggregate of Thirteen Thousand Two hundred and Twenty eight
dollars, and sixteen Cents - That since the sale, and ratification thereof It has
been ascertained by a more accurate survey, made by George Bowler & Thomas
H. DeKal, herewith exhibited, and filed as Exhibit No 1 - That the said lands -
only contain One Thousand and fifty seven acres, and Fifty five perches of Land making
at the price of Seventy five Dollars and sixteen Cents per acre the aggregate sum
of Eleven thousand eight hundred, and twenty one Dollars and twenty five Cents as
the total amount of purchase money your Petitioner pray that the difference may
be allowed as an abatement of the purchase money, and your Petitioner will ever
pray
