Humblly complaining sheweth unto your Honor  
your Orators and Oratrices Joseph L Kubler, William H Stening and Eliza Stening his wife  
E Devilbiss and Louisa Devilbiss his wife, Franklen Kubler, John Leover and Susannah  
Leover his wife, that Jacob Biggs late of said County on the 3rd day of Oct 1822 in due  
form of law made and executed his testament and last will, and in a short time thereafter  
departed this life without having revoked the same a true and certified copy of said will  
is here exhibited as a part of this Bill and marked Exhibit A, which together with all  
other exhibits your orators and oratrices pray may be taken and considered as part of  
this Bill of Complaint as if here inserted - Your Orators and Oratrices further shew unto  
your Honor, that the said Testator by said Will, amongst other things devised as follows  
"I give and devise to my four daughters that is to say, Catharine Knoff, Amy Kubler,  
Susannah and Mary Smith, as tenants in Common, and not as joint tenants, the  
Plantation whereon I now dwell containing about two hundred and eleven acres, and  
part of a tract of land called the "Reservoir or Bucks Forest" containing about one  
hundred and fifteen acres to them their heirs and assigns in fee simple" - Your Orator  
and Oratrices further state that John Smith of Mucow town Carroll County is the Husband
